DIRECT SCHOOL ADMISSION – JUNIOR COLLEGES (DSA-JC)

Students who had accepted offers through 2018 DSA-JC Exercise will be admitted to their chosen JC if they have met the eligibility criteria for admission based on their GCE O-Level examination results
(NOT eligible to participate in JAE)

✓ Students who do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for course which they are eligible for

EARLY ADMISSIONS EXERCISE – POLYTECHNICS (EAE)

☑ Students who had conditional offers to a polytechnic course through 2018 EAE and have their offers confirmed based on their GCE O-Level examination results will <u>NOT</u> be eligible to participate in the JAE

(*Net ELR2B2* ≤ 26)

(Met min entry requirement for the respective polytechnic course)
