The Edusave Character Award (ECHA) is presented to Singaporean students in recognition of their exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions.

**QUOTA OF AWARDS**

The ECHA is capped at 2% of the enrolment of Singaporean students. In BPGHS, the number of awards allocated for each course [Express, Normal (Academic) and Normal (Technical)] will be based on the student enrolment.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Nominees for the ECHA should fulfil the following criteria:

- 1) Must be **Singapore citizens**;
- 2) Must serve as a role model by **consistently demonstrating exemplary character and upholding school values**; and
- 3) Must have a Conduct Grade of **‘Excellent’** or **‘Very Good’**.

The qualities associated with the School Values are listed below:

<p><b>Respect</b> Treats self and others with respect</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Works amiably with others of differing personalities and profiles</li> <li>• Has due regard for the opinions/suggestions of others</li> <li>• Polite and is considerate towards others</li> </ul>
<p><b>Responsibility</b> Fulfils one’s roles and duties to the best of one’s ability</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strives for excellence in whatever he/she does to the best of his/her ability</li> <li>• Holds oneself accountable for all his/her work and actions and never gives excuses for non-fulfilment</li> <li>• Takes initiative and effort to go beyond expectations, without being told exactly what to do</li> </ul>
<p><b>Integrity</b> Being honest and upright in character</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understands moral principles and stands firm on them</li> <li>• Displays moral courage by owing up to own mistakes or by not covering up for friends who have done something wrong</li> </ul>
<p><b>Resilience</b> Being able to cope with change and seize the opportunity for growth</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Perseveres amid difficult circumstances (e.g. financial problems, family issues, health issues, etc.) and manages to overcome the odds</li> <li>• Manifests courage, optimism, adaptability and resourcefulness</li> </ul>
<p><b>Care for Others</b> Acts with kindness and compassion and contributes to the betterment of the community</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shows empathy towards issues faced by others, initiating actions to address these issues to improve the lives of others, and being committed to make a difference</li> <li>• Engages in voluntary community work on his/her own</li> </ul>
