Highlight: We will be attempting to set a new Guinness World Record by having 1200 Lions as the Largest Display of Lion Dance. The previous record of 1111 Lions was set in Hong Kong on 1 Jan 2011. We will be engaging the community and unions as volunteers and performers for this event. The performers will be made up of all walks of life regardless of race and religions. International media will also be expected to cover this event.

Expected crowd: 30,000

To celebrate this joyous occasion, we will be inviting all the religious leaders from the different religious groups to lead an inter-faith prayer as the event commence. We want to take this opportunity to pray for everlasting of Peace and Prosperity for Singapore.

Foreign Head of High Commissions and Embassies, Union and Community Leaders are invitees of the event as well. We are also reaching out to various community partners from the places of worships, business association to clans to garner their support in this historical moment of event

Program Components

Singapore Bicentennial Inter-faith Contribution History 2019

To launch a history walk through video series on how the different faiths came about in Singapore and their timeline of arrival, their contributions they made to Singapore community. Eg, Building of schools, hospitals etc during the times of nation building. This series will be launch and publicised via social media after the show.

Singer Performances

We will have 1 full hour of song and dance performers by local artistes to kick off the show.



Fire Works Display

A short display will be put up towards the show to put a finale bang end to the show.



Multi Racial Performers and Car convoys display

We will be having different ethnic groups coming in with car convoys and bringing their music culture in a mass display format



Inter-faith Prayers for Peace and Prosperity of Singapore

As part of the theme, we will be inviting the major faiths in Singapore to come forward each with a contingent of 200 followers of the faith (signifying 200 years) led by their respective religious leaders to perform a short prayer for the Peace and Prosperity of the nation.



Highlight: Guinness Record Largest Mass Lion Dance Display 2019



To break current record for the **Largest lion dance (two operators)** which currently stands at 1,111 lions (2,222 participants) set by Hong Kong on 1 Jan 2011. We will be displaying 1200 lions to commemorate 200th year of Sir Stamford Raffles's landing on Singapore in the year 1819. The choice of this Lion Dance display signifies Singapore as a Lion City. 1200 Lions symbolise 1 Nation 200 years.

We will be using a mix of brand 600 new lions and 600 existing ones to represent the social diversity and the transitioning one generation of Singaporean to the next in creating this record. The new lion heads will be customised into red and white colour to symbolise Singapore's Lion City.

The 3 hours show display will see about 5,000 participants and volunteers coming together from all walks of lives and around the world to put up a multi-racial show and complete the greatest feat in the history of Lion Dance culture

Volunteers required

Guinness World Record Performers (Lion Dance Display): Total Volunteers required 2,000



As the GWR is a national effort, we look forward to volunteers from all walks of life whom is keen to be part of the lion dance display. You **do not** need to have any knowledge of lion dance performance. We will be teaching them the moves in the day starting 9am. You will be required to perform only basic movements.

Car Convoy Segment: Musicians required (Malay Percussion, Indian drummers, Western Percussion 54 players Each)



As part of the multi-racial display, we are seeking 54 musicians from each racial group to put up a 5 min segment each.

Event Ushers: 600 pax required



With such a scale of event, we would require many ushers to ensure the smooth running and execution of the show. Some ushers will be deployed to direct crowd traffic while some will assist in the dotting of lions during the show.
