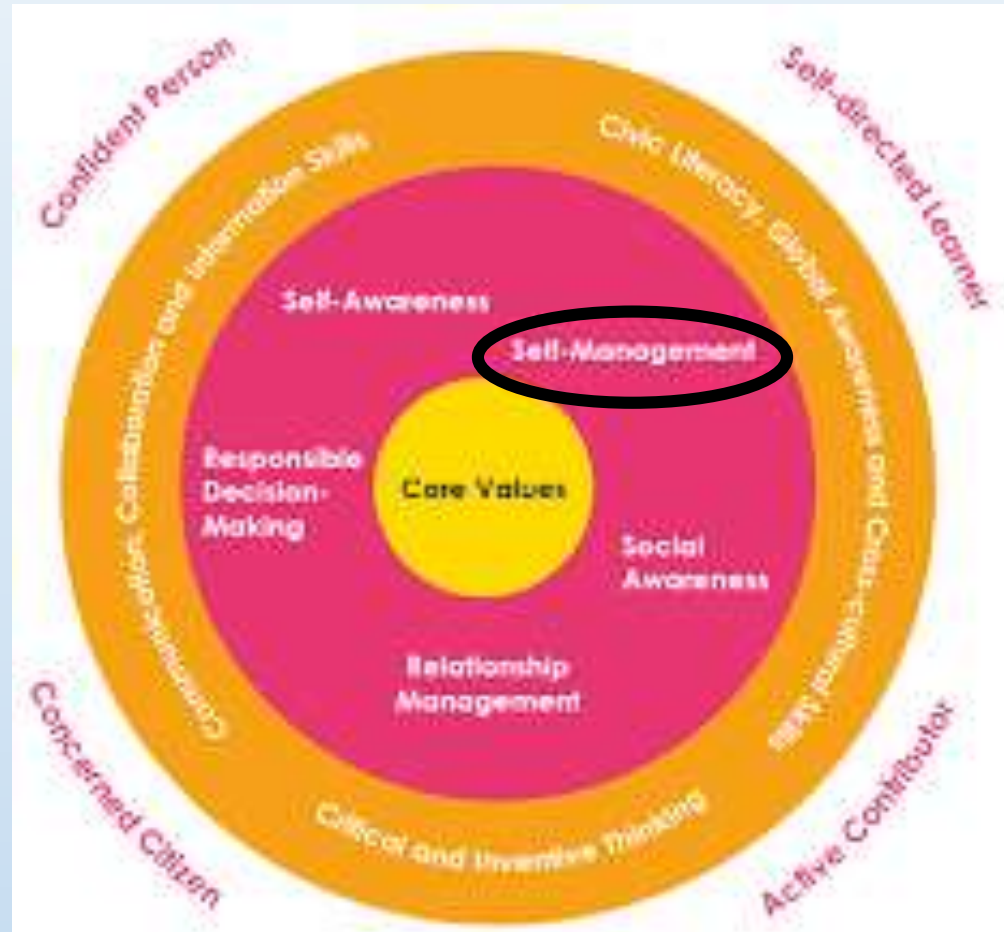

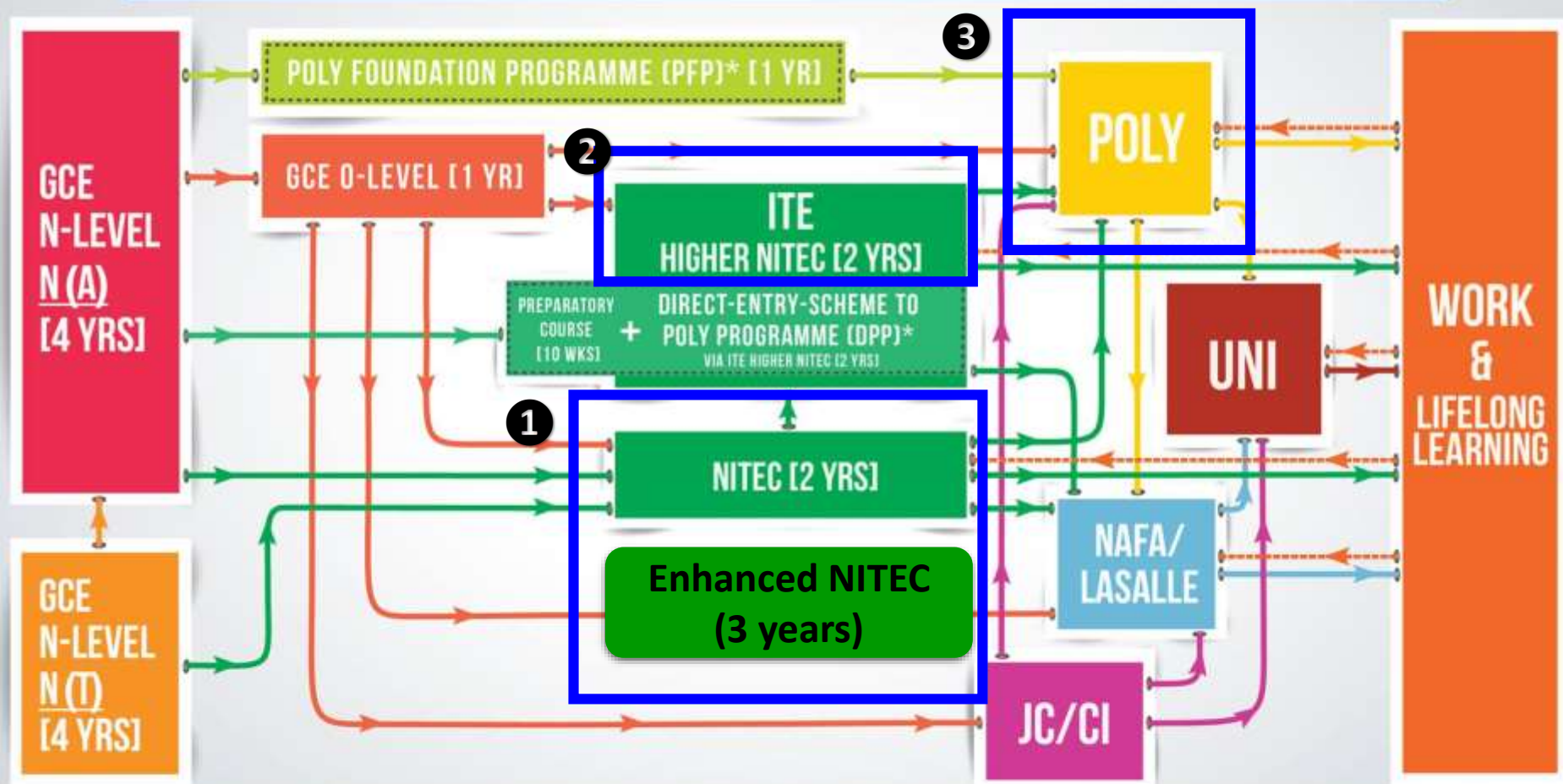

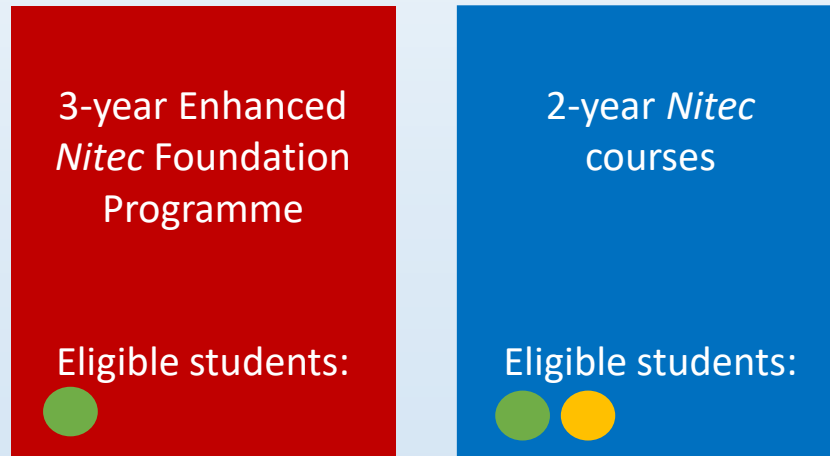

# MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)

## Eligibility

- 1) Singaporean
- 2) Total Household Income (THI) per month  $\leq$  \$2500  
or  
Per Capita Income (PCI) per month  $\leq$  \$625

## Application

- 1) Application is open throughout the year
- 2) Recipients of MOE FAS need to **re-apply every year**

# MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)

## Benefits / Subsidies

- 1) 100% waiver of school fees
- 2) 100% waiver of standard miscellaneous fees
- 3) Free textbooks and stationery in the approved textbook list
- 4) Free school attire comprising 2 sets of uniform, 2 sets of PE attire, 2 pairs of socks and 1 pair of shoes
- 5) Transport subsidy for students taking public transport to school
- 6) Meal subsidy for students
