Participation Domain in LEAPS 2.0

- At least 75% attendance each year
 - Levels 1 - 4:
 - Participation in a CCA for 2 to 5 years
 - Levels 4 – 5:
 - Continuous involvement in the same CCA for 4 or 5 years
 - Levels 3 – 5:
 - **Exemplary conduct and active contribution** in CCA with at least 3 years of participation in any CCA

CCA Policy

Participation

- CCA participation is **compulsory** for all pupils.
- All pupils are expected to take part in **at least one CCA** from the 4 groups, namely, Sports and Games, Uniformed Groups, Performing Arts, and Clubs & Societies.
- This CCA must be a **school-based CCA**
- At least **85%** attendance rate

CCA Programme

- At the end of a student's secondary education, he/she will receive an attainment band for his/her CCA experience.
- The attainment will be converted to bonus points for gaining admission into junior colleges/centralized institutions or the polytechnics.

CCA Road show and Registration

- Compulsory for all Sec 1 students to go for trials/interviews and /or auditions of their top 3 choices (minimally).

- Allocation is based on talents, preferences and vacancies in CCA.
