A) NRIC Registration at School

- 7. Under the National Registration Regulations, all Singapore Citizens (SC) and Permanent Residents (SPR) are required to register for their NRIC in the year the child attains the age of 15 years. The mobile registration team from the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) will be carrying out the NRIC registration for our students in the school on **4 March 2019 at 1 pm**.
- 8. You will receive a **NOTIFICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF NRIC** from the ICA two weeks before the registration exercise. Kindly ensure that the form is duly completed.
- 9. On the day of the NRIC registration, your child/ward will need to bring the following original items:
 - a. Letter of Notification, duly completed
 - b. One recent passport-sized colour photograph (35 by 45 mm) taken against a white background and with a matt or semi-matt finish eyebrows should not be covered by hair
 - c. Ezlink card/School Smart Card with top up value of minimum \$10 for SC and \$50 for SPR. (For payment by credit card, please fill in the details in the notification letter.)
 - d. Original and one photocopy of deed poll executed by both parents for change of name (including ethnic characters). If the deed poll was executed by only one of the parents, the other parent is required to go to ICA building to complete a declaration that he/she consents to the name change
 - e. Original and one photocopy of Baptism or Religious Certificate for insertion of religious name, if any
 - f. Foreign Passport, Certificate of Identity (if any), with valid Re-Entry Permit (for SPR only)
- 10. Please note that if your child/ward is not able to register for his/her NRIC in the school, he/she will be required to produce his/her original birth certificate and photocopies of both parent's NRIC as well when he/she registers at the ICA. In preparation for the NRIC registration, your child/ward will be having a photo-taking session after school on **7 Jan 2019, Monday.** He/She is expected to wear full school uniform with tie on that day.

B) MOE Outward Bound Singapore (OBS) Camp

11. As per the letter issued to all parents on 25 October 2018, all Secondary 3 students will participate in the Outward Bound Singapore Camp (27 – 31 May 2019) as part of the National Outdoor Adventure Education Masterplan which MOE has put in place to strengthen the holistic development of all our students. As mentioned, there will be a basic medical examination conducted after school on 8 and 11 January 2019 to facilitate the registration process. Your child/ward should have submitted the course registration form by today. If your child/ward has not done so, please submit the form as soon as possible. There is also a briefing on the OBS Camp on 8 March 2019 during the Meet the Parents session.
