
#### Singapore's Education System: An Overview








### Subject-Based Banding (SBB) at LS

- SBB provides greater flexibility in subject offering at lower secondary levels, to better cater to the strengths of the students in different subjects and enhance their access to opportunities throughout their educational journey.
- N(A) students may have taken some SBB subjects at Express level for English, Maths, Science and Mother Tongue Language. Each student cannot take more than 3 subjects at higher level.

### Out-of-Stream Subjects at US

- The school will offer out-of-stream subjects, i.e. subjects at a higher level, to eligible Sec 3 N(A) students for English, Maths, Science and Mother Tongue.
- However, similarly, each student can only offer up to a maximum of 3
   out-of-stream subjects.

#### 1. When will the streaming exercise start?

The streaming exercise will start after the End-of-Year Examinations. It starts 26 Oct and ends 1 Nov 2022, 12pm.

#### 2. If we are overseas during the streaming exercise, how can we apply?

#### 3. How many options do we need to select?

You need to rank your options according to your preference.

#### 4. What if I miss the streaming exercise?

A random subject combination will be assigned to you based on availability.

#### 5. If I didn't get my preferred choice, can I appeal?

The appeal window is from 5 Nov – 7 Nov 2022, 12pm. You can only appeal through the website <a href="https://bpghs.adminbreeze.com/">https://bpghs.adminbreeze.com/</a>.

### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

#### 6. How many subjects am I taking?

6 subjects. This includes English, Mother Tongue, Maths, Science (C+P or C+B), Elective Humanities (SS + Hist/Geog/Lit in EL) and one Elective (A Maths/POA/Art/D&T/F&N). Students exempted from Mother Tongue will have to take two Electives, one of which must be a coursework subject (Art/D&T/F&N).

7. What is the condition for studying N-Level Additional Mathematics?

You must get at least 65% Overall for your Sec 2 Maths.
