Met Minimum Attainment Level:

Grade D or better in 2 subjects, one of which should be English Language or Mathematics

Sec 2N(T)

Promoted to Sec 3N(T)

Met Minimum Attainment Level AND

Lateral Transfer Requirement:

- Minimum 70% for the combined percentage of all subjects
- Found suitable with at least 70% for EL, Maths and Science, and positive feedback from form/subject teachers

Laterally Transferred to Sec 2N(A) in the following year

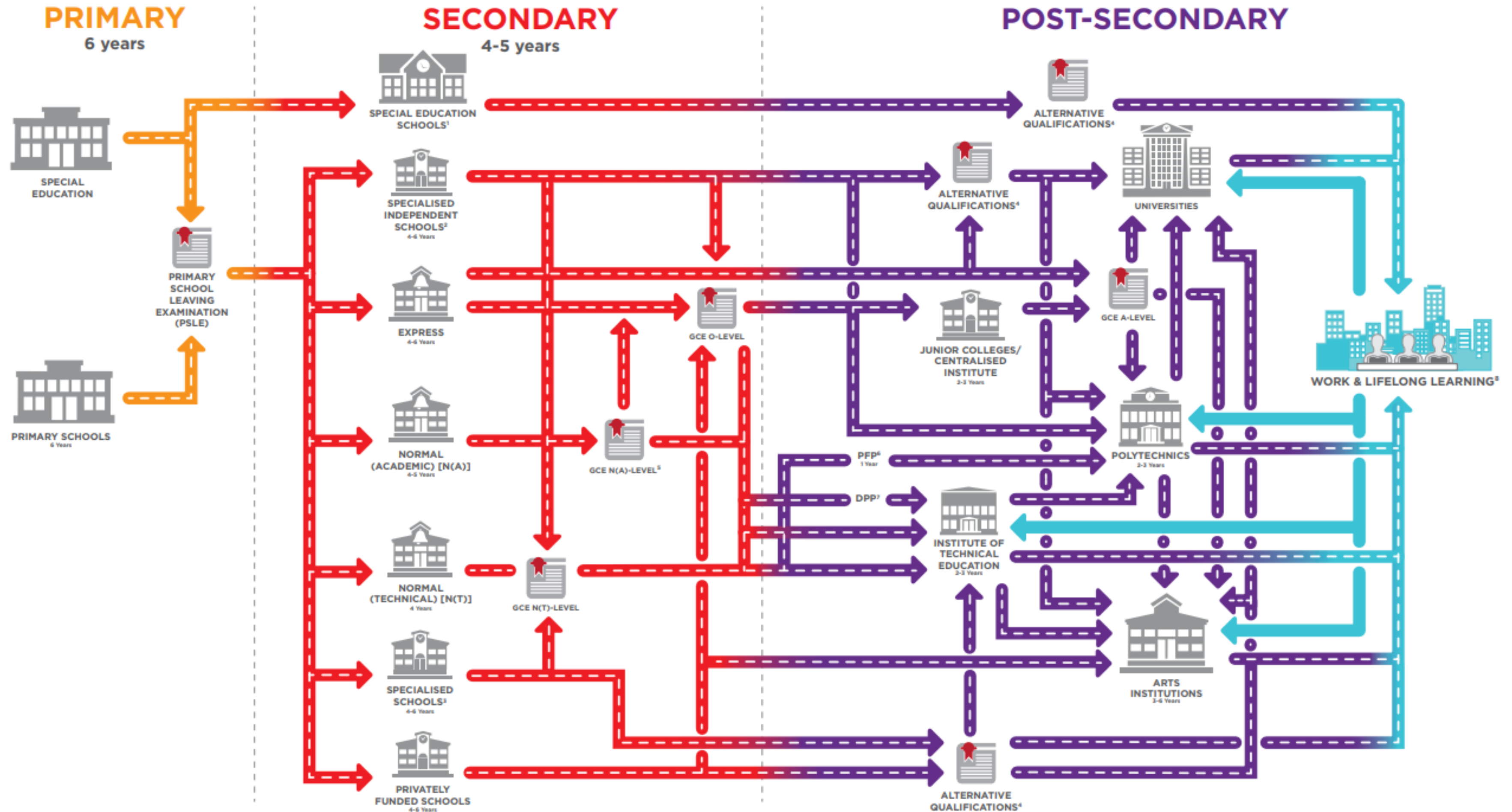

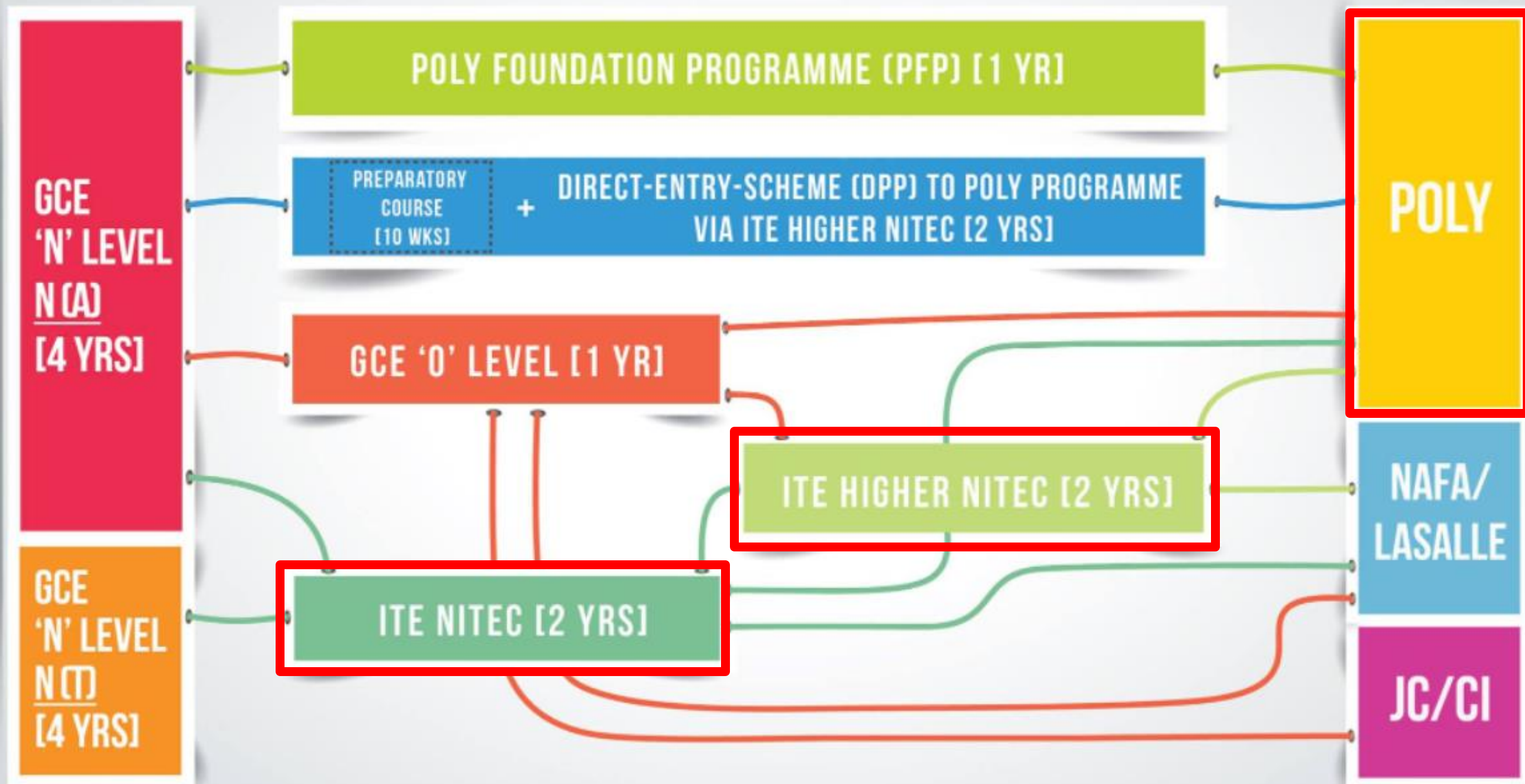

Entry Requirements for Progression to ITE and onwards

- To enter a NITEC course, the minimum requirement is 3 GCE N Passes
- Certain courses have subject-specific requirements
 - “Service Skills” or “Attractions Operations” – Pass in English
 - “Applied Food Science” or “Chemical Process Technology” – Pass in Maths AND Science

Aggregate Computation

The aggregate computation for admission to ITE is based on your 4 best subjects, including the required subjects specified by the specific course.

Subject-Based Banding (SBB) at LS

- *SBB provides greater flexibility in subject offering at lower secondary levels, to better cater to the strengths of the students in different subjects and enhance their access to opportunities throughout their educational journey.*
- *N(T) students may have taken some SBB subjects at N(A) level for English, Maths, Science and Mother Tongue Language. Each student cannot take more than 3 subjects at higher level.*

Out-of-Stream Subjects at US

- *The school will offer out-of-stream subjects, i.e. subjects at a higher level, to eligible Sec 3 N(T) students for English, Maths, Science and Mother Tongue.*
- *However, similarly, each student can only offer **up to a maximum of 3** out-of-stream subjects.*
