Remedial / Consultation Sessions

6. The school has also planned the following workshops in Term One to endow our graduating cohort with essential life skills and self-management:

a) Education & Career Guidance Programme (Sec 4/5)

The intent of this programme is to assist students to make more informed choices about their next education pathway. The programme is scheduled to take place on 14 March 2019.

b) Visits to Polytechnics (Sec 4/5)

The objective of these visits is to allow our graduating students to probe further into the different courses of study offered by polytechnics to allow them to make informed choices after their graduation from secondary school. The visits are scheduled to take place in Semester One. The Secondary 5 students will visit Nanyang Polytechnic, accompanied by their Form teachers on 3 Jan 2019. They are also to make arrangements to visit the various polytechnics open house on their own from 9 – 11 Jan 2019. They need not report to school on 9 – 11 Jan 2019.

c) Enrichment Programmes (Sec 5 only)

The objective of the programmes is to allow our Sec 5 students to get to know possible options in polytechnics which they may want to offer. They will be visiting the Asian Civilisations Museum on 4 Jan 2019 in order to understand and appreciate the history of our heritage and the Science Centre on 7 Jan 2019 to attend a Science workshop to explore their interest in a Science should they decide to pursue a Science-related course in polytechnic. In order to better prepare them for project presentations and job interviews in the future, there will also be a public speaking and interview skills workshop conducted on 8 Jan 2019.
