GCE N(A)-Level Examination

1. Your child/ ward has been working diligently to prepare for the coming national examination. Our continued support and encouragement will mean a lot to him/ her.
2. He/ She will be sitting for the GCE N-level Examination on 11, 13 and 18 September, as well as on 2 to 13 October. He/ She will also be sitting for the GCE O-level Examination for English Language and Mother Tongue Languages. A copy of the examination timetable (updated 15 February) is available on our school's website.
3. On the days of examinations, students will report to school at least half an hour before the start of their papers. On the days when there is no examination, they will continue to report to school as per normal for revision and consultation with their subject teachers until **29 September**, which is the last day of school for Secondary Four and Five students. **Attendance is compulsory.**

19 – 29 September	Report to school. Lessons as per normal.
2 – 13 October	GCE N-level Examination.
23 October onwards	GCE O-Level Examination for selected subjects.

4. From 2 October, students who are sitting for their national examinations may continue to use the school facilities for their self-study and to seek consultation with their teachers. They are expected to adhere to school regulations including those related to attire and code of conduct.
