Updates for Semester 2 2018 (Secondary 4NA)

Our school aims to provide a conducive environment for students to deepen and engage in learning, and to prepare them for their post-secondary education and future careers. Various platforms were organised for students to experience authentic learning outside the classrooms such as the Sandcastle Buidling and the co-curriculum programmes to develop them to be passionate learners and inspiring leaders.

2. As a school, we also continue to review our programmes and processes to enhance and meet the needs of our students for their general well-being and holistic development.

3. We have made enhancements to the timetable to allow for provisions for form teachers to conduct conferencing and activities with students, as well as structured silent reading time to inculcate good reading habits. School dismissal timings have thus been extended by 10 minutes, adjusted to end at 1.40 pm on short days and 2.40 pm on long days. In view of this, we have also adjusted the recess and snack break timing later to ensure students' well-being is taken care of. The updated timetable structure and after-school schedule is appended in Annex A and B for reference.

GCE N(A)-Level Examination

6. Your child has been working diligently to prepare for the upcoming national examination in Semester 2. In the lead up to their national examination, the school preliminary examination will commence from 25 July.

7. After the school preliminary examination, your child will be sitting for the GCE N-Level Examination on 10, 12, 13 and 17 September, as well as on 1 to 12 October. He/She will also be sitting for the GCE O-Level Examination for English Language and Mother Tongue Languages. A copy of the examination timetable (updated as at 20 February) will be made available on the school's website.

8. On the days of examinations, students will report to school at least half an hour before the start of their papers. On the days when there is no examination, they will continue to report to school as per normal for revision and consultation with their subject

teachers until **28 September**, which is the last day of school for Secondary 4 and 5 students. Attendance is compulsory.

9. Between **16 and 19 October**, there will be a 1 week structured consolidation to support students' preparing for their GCE O-Level Examinations for selected subjects. During this period, students may continue to use the school facilities for their self-study and seek consultation with their teachers. They are expected to adhere to school regulations including those related to attire and code of conduct.

10. We wish your child every success in the national examination and future endeavours. We would like to thank you for your partnership with the school to support your child in his/her journey to prepare for the upcoming national examination. Our continued support and encouragement will mean a lot to him/ her.
